Or use pathway: Menu -> Inventory -> Inventory Planning -> click on Restock Inventory

Alternatively, on the home page of Seller Central, click the IPI box, then click the number, scroll down to Restock Report

Only hide the items showing “No action required”. The items recommended for restock are a potential goldmine, so source those first as they are true replens that Amazon wants more of. Obviously, make sure there is a profit at the current selling price.

Once a week or so, I would go through the hidden items and see if there could be new recommendations for them. If you've been OOS for a while, it may not show recommended restock quantities simply because you don't have recent sales history on that ASIN. Evaluate it as you would any new product and see if there could potentially be room for you to send in a handful of units and see how they move.
